recover Vict. Vict had been kidnapped by Def (Vict's grandmother) from Vict's home in North Carolina. Upon our arrival the following occurred:

- We met with Def at location.
- Def identified herself, and advised that Vict was inside location.
- Def invited us inside location, and called for Vict to come out of the bedroom.

Def told us the following:

- Def explained that Vict is her granddaughter, and that she had picked her up in North Carolina because she was going to spend a month in Michigan for vacation.
- While in North Carolina Def discovered that Vict had many bruises all over her body.
- Vict told Def that her guardian Carolyn Ochoa (W/F unknown DOB) had caused her bruises.
- Carolyn was the Vict's aunt by marriage, but has since divorced Vict's uncle.
- The courts awarded custody to Carolyn Ochoa after the divorce was final.
- Def had already gained permission from Vict's guardian Carolyn to take Vict back to Michigan with her.
- Def left Carolyn a note (see attached) regarding Vict's allegations of abuse.

- Def stated that she knows that she should not have taken Vict, but that she did not know what else to do.

Vict came to the living room, and told us the following:

- Def showed us the bruises on Vict's face, arms, and buttocks.
- We asked Vict who had hurt her, and she stated "My Aunt-Mom".
- We asked Vict what had caused her bruises.
- Vict said that her "Aunt-Mom Carolyn" had spanked her butt with a spatula a couple of days ago.
- Vict then told us that Carolyn had banged her head on the dresser in the bedroom.

Officer's Observations:

- We observed numerous faded bruises covering Vict's buttocks.
- We also observed faded bruises on Vict's temple and arms.
- The bruises appeared to be several days old.
- Vict appeared extremely thin for a child her age.
- Vict's ribs were completely visible when her shirt was off.
- Vict appeared fearful when she spoke about her guardian Carolyn.

Officer's Actions:

- We advised Def that we needed to take her and Vict to TPD for questioning regarding the abuse and kidnapping allegations.
- Def and Vict were transported to TPD without incident.
- Def and Vict were shown to the interview room.
- Vict was given lunch while awaiting for Youth Bureau Detectives to interview her.
- I contacted Detective W. L. Condry from Jacksonville N.C. Police Department.
- He advised that he has a valid warrant for Def's arrest, and that his agency will extradite Def.
- Sgt. Campbell from Jacksonville N.C. Police Department faxed a copy of Def's warrant for 2nd Degree Kidnapping.
- I advised Detective Condry that Detective Robinson would be handling the case for TPD.
- Detective Condry requested that we fax all information regarding this case to him.
- Vict was turned over to Cdt. Goldsmith in the Youth Sentry room.
- Def was placed under arrest, handcuffed (DL/CT), and was taken back to booking area without incident.
- Def is being held without bond pending extradition from Jacksonville N.C. PD.
